“Wise Icebergs” is a research project focusing on the thoughts of the Indian philosopher Krishnamurti, who developed a thesis based mainly on the idea that human beings can only be transformed by freeing themselves from all forms of authority. He used the metaphor of the iceberg in his writings, and this inspired my sculptures and a series of collages referencing geometrical forms found in nature. The iceberg is made either of terracotta or plaster, with a coloured glass or plexiglass plate acting as a “separation”. Whenever possible, I would like to work in collaboration with local craftspeople. Working on forms is in itself an active thought process that I like to carry out like a kind of conscious and unconscious meditation.
